

ESSAYS ON HOUSING AND COHABITATION IN THE (PRE)MODERN CITY OF LISBON AND THE HISTORIC CITY OF FARO, UNDER THE AEGIS OF THE CONCEPTS OF DWELLING, TEMPORARY HOUSING, HERITAGE, COMMON HOUSE, COLLABORATIVE ESSAYS, INDETERMINATE TYPOLOGY, RE-READING, IMPUNITY AND OPPORTUNITY.

The research carried out during the winter and summer semesters of 2023-24, focused on specific urban contexts, Lisbon and Faro, under the guidance of different teaching teams, reflecting unique approaches to the urban and social conditions of each location.


During the winter term, students developed the 'Close to the View' exercise in the Santa Maria de Alcamim/São Cristóvão area of Lisbon. They worked on five vacant lots, proposing housing solutions that reflect the historical and cultural transformations of the area, combining family housing (studios and one-bedroom apartments) with temporary and tourist units, incorporating common spaces adapted to the new housing needs of Lisbon, where tourist pressure and heritage preservation intersect.

The intervention site, with strong traces of multiple cultures and a complex urban history, forced the students to critically reflect on their proposals, reconciling contemporary housing design with urban memory. The solutions presented explored not only rehabilitation, but also the integration of different social practices, in line with the dynamics of this neighbourhood.

During the summer term, the students developed the 'Living Together' project in Faro. The use of cooperative and collaborative models such as 'cohousing' was proposed as a response to the lack of affordable housing. They intervened in two plots of land in Vila Adentro, close to the Convent of Our Lady of the Assumption and the Magisterium, proposing the re-qualification of Largo Afonso III, promoting the transition from a car-dominated city to a more human scale.

Students had to rethink traditional domestic layouts reconsidering housing typologies to meet contemporary needs such as teleworking, ageing and energy sustainability. The design of environments that facilitate interaction between residents was prioritised, with shared spaces such as kitchens and other communal areas that integrate intergenerational living.

The exhibition showcases the results, where students were challenged to question ways of living and adapt them to current urban and social realities. From Lisbon to Faro, the projects on display demonstrate a critical and innovative approach to collective housing and urban regeneration, highlighting the importance of inclusive and sustainable solutions for our cities.



Location of the five vacant lots for intervention. S. Maria de Alcamim neighborhood



↑ Study of typologies – process
